Overview

Raigad Fort, perched at an altitude of 2,700 feet in the Sahyadri mountain range, is a historic marvel in Maharashtra, India. Constructed in the 14th century, it gained prominence in the 17th century when Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, the founder of the Maratha Empire, chose it as his capital in 1674. Surrounded by dense forests and rugged terrain, Raigad was a formidable stronghold, symbolizing Maratha pride and strategic acumen. It served as the nerve center of Shivaji's administration and a bulwark against invasions, playing a pivotal role in consolidating Maratha power. The fort's majestic architecture, including the royal palaces, markets, and the iconic Jagadishwar Temple, reflects its historical significance and natural beauty.

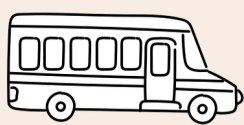

DAY 1 - 09:00 AM

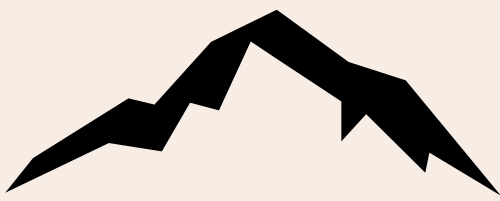
Will reach the top and will start exploring fort. Click pictures

DAY 1 - 02:00 PM

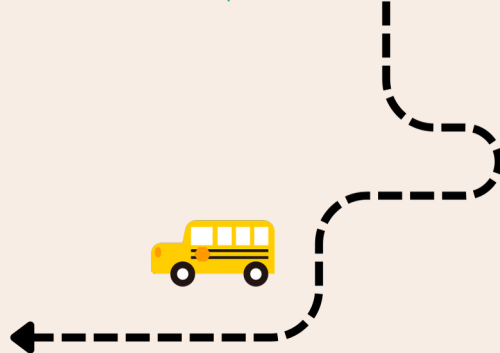
Will Reach Base Village and Have Lunch
